

Living the Paschal Mystery

The root of all religious desire is union with God. The bold claim of Christianity is that God meets this desire by coming to us in Christ, and we come to God in Christ: "No one comes to the Father except through me." As the Lectionary moves us toward Pentecost, we find ourselves more and more challenged to encounter the risen Jesus, to believe deeply that he is risen and dwells among and within us. We encounter Jesus and come to greater belief by doing the works of Jesus and by recognizing the risen Jesus in the other. The very practical challenge here is that our baptism plunges us not only into a relationship with the triune God, but also into a profound relationship with each other. Therefore, our belief in the resurrection and the Good news of salvation is played out concretely in the way we treat others in justice, mercy, forgiveness, and love. Relationships always make demands on us. Moreover, we cannot have a relationship with Jesus and the Father without relationships with each other. That is both the challenge and the good news. It is also the promise that Jesus' leave-taking is not long-term. He is always with us.


